God has been declaring a Saviour, which is Christ, the Lord! Look at the words Isaiah recorded: *All ye, assemble yourselves, and hear; which among them hath declared these things? The Lord hath loved him: he will do his pleasure on Babylon, and his arm shall be on the Chaldeans. I, even I, have spoken; yea, I have called him: I have brought him, and he shall make his way prosperous* (Isaiah 48:14-15).

God the Father declared of his only begotten Son that Jesus would make his way prosperous. Christ himself declares, Come ye near unto me, hear ye this; I have not spoken in secret from the beginning; from the time that it was, there am I: and now the Lord God, and his Spirit, hath sent me. Thus saith the Lord, thy Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel; I am the Lord thy God which teacheth thee to profit, which leadeth thee by the way that thou shouldest go (Isaiah 48:16-17).

The Saviour, the Holy One of Israel, in turn, will teach us to profit. What is this prosperity? It is not money, nor possessions. It is not health, or fame and influence.

The first time the word *prosper* is used in Scripture is by Abraham. He is assuring his servant that the Lord would *prosper* his way as he seeks a bride for Isaac (Genesis 24:40). The second use is by Abraham's servant when he asks the Lord God to *prosper* his way as he seeks Isaac's bride (Genesis 24:442).

The Lord Jesus Christ died for our sins according to the Scripture and rose again the third day (Luke 24:46). He made his way to prosper: the seeking of that which was lost! Jesus Christ will, in turn, teach us to prosper in reaching souls for Christ as his Spirit seeks to establish the churches in the faith and to increase their number daily (Acts 16:5). Faith in Christ is eternal prosperity!
