## We Will Live Somewhere Forever!

Judgment is eternal (Hebrews 6:2). Even as Sodom and Gomorrah, and the cities about them in like manner, going after strange flesh, are set forth for an example, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire (Jude 1:7). That fire, termed *hell fire* by our Lord (Mark 9:47), is where the worm dies not and where the fire is not quenched (Mark 9:46).

Judgment, by Christ, is certain: For the Father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son: that all men should honour the Son, even as they honour the Father. He that honoureth not the Son honoureth not the Father which hath sent him (John 5:22-23).

Jesus said plainly, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life (John 5:24). Why is this important? Because there are two resurrections: Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice, and shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation (John 5:28-29).

The first resurrection, the resurrection of life, began with Jesus Christ himself. He is the firstfruits: *But now is Christ risen from the dead, and become the firstfruits of them that slept* (1 Corinthians 15:20). Every man in his order: *Christ the firstfruits; afterward them that are Christ's at his coming. Then cometh the end...* (1 Corinthians 15:23-24).

This first resurrection will be completed with the resurrection of the saints beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and which had not worshipped the beast...they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years (Revelation 20:4). But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished (Revelation 20:5).

Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with him a thousand years (Revelation 20:6).

The second death, which is the lake of fire (Revelation 20:14) is keyed to the resurrection of damnation (John 5:29). Raised to face the great White Throne, they will be judged according to their works (Revelation 20:13), under condemnation (John 3:18). Even religious men who say to Christ, *Lord*, *Lord*; but who have not done the will of his Father, they shall hear him say, *I never knew you* (Matthew 7:21-23). What is the Father's will? That we honor the Son as we honor the Father (John 5:22-24).
